



The story in the Torah portion, Bo, happens every day. It's a reminder that the everyday miracles that are no less routine, might overlook. spectacular.

Nahmanides (Ramban) offers profound insight into our understanding of miracles. For him, the fact the sun

is alive with God's mighty acts - the the extraordinary isn't always found in plagues, the Exodus from Egypt - but rare, awe-inspiring events but often in it also carries a deeper message about the magnificent wonders that we, in our

Parashat Bo is not just about recalling a ancient wonders but it is about feeling their presence in our lives today. The commandments, especially those rises every day is no less miraculous than commemorating the Exodus, serve as the splitting of the Red Sea. Through his strong and vibrant links that connect eyes, we realize that the sunrise is not a us to a time when miracles were mundane event; it's a grand miracle that unmistakable, helping us to see the


grandeur in what we might consider ordinary. Each mitzvah is an affirmation that the miracles of yesterday are still with us, echoing in our daily lives.




