Torah on Tour

Faith vs. Trust by Rabbi Jarrod Grover

Pharaoh is utterly defeated at the Red Sea. Upon witnessing this salvation, the Torah tells us that "the people had faith in God and Moses, his servant." What was this faith - and why was it relevant to what they had just witnessed?

Rabbi Avraham Ibn Ezra argues that upon witnessing the salvation, our ancestors believed that God was true. Their experience led to a philosophical conclusion about God's existence. All doubt vanished. Rabbi Shmuel ben Meir disagrees. He explains that upon seeing their deliverance

from Pharaoh, the people trusted that God would protect and provide for them in the desert.

Faith and trust are similar, yet different. While Hebrew uses the same word for both concepts, faith speaks to what we believe; trust speaks to how we act. For us, the former is quite useless without the latter. It takes trust to enter a place of danger. It takes trust to leave behind that with which one is familiar. It takes trust to sustain our priorities and commitments in a turbulent world.
