# Torah on Tour

## Insides and Outsides by Rabbi Jarrod Grover

The construction of the Mishkan called for the Israelites to bring individual gifts. Abravanel (Spain, 16th c.) understands the multiple materials used for the construction of the mishkan as representations of the various types of people contributing to it, none with a greater stake or importance, rather, all a part of the sacred task. Multiple commentaries underscore that it takes all types of people. Alone, even Moses didn't have everything needed.

Even today, each of us is called to appreciate our own divine gifts and use our individual talents for the good of the community. According to the Talmud, this message is inherent in the instructions for the Mishkan. The ark was to be overlaid with pure gold, inside and outside, "tocho k'devero". This is a metaphor for the life – our insides must match our outsides.

About leadership, the great American scholar Warren Bennis wrote: "Becoming a leader is synonymous with becoming yourself. It is precisely

that simple and it is also that difficult." Inside ourselves lies our compassion, our courage and our creativity – essential tools for the building of the sacred.

As we learn from the upcoming Purim holiday, Queen Esther emerges as heroine after she unmask her identity. Not by ascending to the position of queen, but by acknowledging her identity, revealing her true self, and finding her own compassion, courage and creativity, does she save her people.
