# Torah on Tour

## Aaron's Sin by Rabbi Jarrod Grover

We should feel sympathy for Aaron in his handling of the episode of the Golden Calf. While his brother Moses is with God, Aaron faces a restive crowd below, and is desperately trying to hold them off. As Rashi notes, Aaron's suggestion that the people surrender their jewelry was a delaying tactic until Moses would return, but the people readily relinquished their gold.

All religious leaders face moments when they confront demands to abandon their religious or moral compass to satisfy their constituents. Will they have the courage in such moments to stand strong for principle? Will they try to delay or distract? Or will they cave in and rationalize their actions? In the Talmud (b. Megillah 25b) Rabbi

Shimon b. Yohai notes that Aaron's sin may have been more subtle—he didn't speak clearly when the crisis began, and thus opened the way to misunderstanding and misconduct. How difficult it is to lead decisively when faced with confusing and frightening realities!

Looking at the landscape of contemporary Jewish life, we should feel deep concern over the pressures being put on our leaders. There are pressures to abandon principle, to cease to stand for Jewish values, to back away from core commandments, all in pursuit of an elusive and unruly horde. It's easy to blame them, but usually, as De Maistre famously wrote, people get the leaders they deserve.
