INSTRUCTIONS:

Print out the texts below before *Simchat Torah*, one printout per participant of all ages. Get your honey ready! Go to your online services, daven with your community. When you get to the *Hakafot*, wait for your service leader to give instructions. Remember to be joyous!

First Hakafah Text:

אָדָני ְיהִוֹה נְתַן לִי לְשִׁון לִּ וּדִּים לָדָעַת לָעַ ת אֶת־יִעֶף גּבָר יִעְיר

The Lord God gave me a skilled tongue to know how to speak timely words to the weary (Isaiah 50: 4)

Second Hakafah Text:

ָכֶן־אָדָם ֹכִטְנֵרְ תָאֲכֶל ֹּוֹמֵעֶיךְ תְמַלֵּא אָת הַ גְּלָה הֵּזֹאת אֲשֶׁר אָנִי נֹתֶן אֵלִירְ וֹאִכְלָּה וַ, הִי ְכְפִּי ִ דְבָּ 'לְמִתְּץְקּ 'Mortal, feed your stomach and fill your belly with this scroll that I give you.' I ate it, and it tasted as sweet as honey to me.

Third Hakafah Text:

Sweetness drops From your lips, O bride; Honey and milk Are under your tongue (Song of Songs 4:4)

Fourth *Hakafah* Text:

When God began to create heaven and earth...(Genesis 1:1)

Fifth *Hakafah*Text:
