

RABBI'S MESSAGE

Dear Friends, *amosh*

לְדֹר וָדֹר אֱמוּנָתְךָ כּוֹנֵנֶת אֶרֶץ וַתַּעֲמֵד

Your faith endures from generation to generation, You (*Hashem*) established earth and it stands firm. (*Tehillim* 119:90)

The simple meaning of this *Passuk* is that faith in God endures forever, as does the earth that He created. But as in the phrase we recite each morning upon awakening,

רַבָּה אֱמוּנָתְךָ ... מוֹדָה אֲנִי - great is "Your Faith," – אֱמוּנָתְךָ refers not only to *our* faith in God, but conversely, it highlights *His* faith in *us*.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

In welcoming you to the Young Israel of Jamaica Estates 39th Anniversary Dinner, I find myself contemplating not only the twelve remarkable individuals we are honoring in 2018. I find myself contemplating fifteen remarkable individuals—fifteen visionaries—without whom we wouldn't be here tonight. They made their mark in 1912.

In 2018, when America is blessed with a thriving Torah-observant population, it is hard to believe that a mere century ago, Orthodoxy was on the brink of disintegration. To quote *Returning to Tradition: The Contemporary Revival of Orthodox Judaism* by M. Herbert Danzger:

“Young people brought up in America were embarrassed by parents with foreign accents and clothing, European foods and style of life, old-fashioned ways and religion. The impoverished immigrant parents lacked education in the American culture. Children sought to escape this ‘ignorant’ lower-class ethnic world and to become Americans.”

In other words, young Jews were voting with their feet in droves, fleeing their parents and their Judaism as quickly as they could. Witnessing this tragedy, fifteen lay leaders took action in 1912. Committed to saving Torah life, they founded the Young Israel movement.

Virtually from its inception, Young Israel had as its motto a passage from the Prophet Malachi (3:24):

“וְהָשִׁיב לֵב-אֲבוֹת עַל-בְּנֵיהֶם, וְלֵב בְּנֵיהֶם עַל-אֲבוֹתָם”

“And He shall turn the heart of the parents to the children, and the heart of the children to the parents.”

How fitting that in 2018, our Young Israel—nurtured by that motto—is honoring parents and children whose hearts are joined together, united in service to their family, to their synagogue, to their community and to their People.

About the three couples who comprise this year's “senior” honorees, here are but a few of my reflections regarding what makes each of them so remarkable:

Phil Fyman: I remember when Phil and I used to daven at the Yeshiva High School of Queens building in Holliswood, when the YIJE was being built. It's one thing to be committed to a shul when it is fully established; it is another thing entirely to have a vision of, and commitment to, a shul that has yet to be built. Phil had that vision and that commitment. And he still does.

Ruthie Fyman: Long before marrying Phil and moving to Jamaica Estates, Ruthie had a reputation for outstanding community service in Queens. That reputation was only solidified in her new neighborhood.


