## GENERAL RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS

## BANNER LIKE NEVER BEFORE (300 Pts.)

This year's art project will primarily be worked on Sunday morning and may be subsequently worked on at any time during Color War at the general's discretion. Instructions will be provided.

## DRAMATIC PRESENTATION (200 Pts.)

Dramatic Presentation should be approximately five - ten minutes long. It should properly incorporate the theme of Color War (see page 2). It will be worth up to 200 Points ( 150 points for content \& 50 points for actual presentation). Each team will email a rough draft of their script to youth@yije.org by 11:OOP.M. ON WEDNESDAY, MAY $5^{\text {TH }}$ and the final draft (for approval and judging) by 11:00 P.M. ON THURSDAY, MAY $6^{\text {th }}$.

## VIDEO PRESENTATION (150 Pts.)

Each team must create a video of pictures and/or video footage taken during Color War events and set to music. Each team must submit final video for judging NO LATER THAN 5:15PM FRIDAY, MAY $7^{\text {TH }}$.

## DIVREI TORAH

Judges will award points based on the amount of effort the individual and the team has put into the Divrei Torah and on how seriously this event is taken. The delivery of an individual D'var Torah will not be taken into account.

## LETTERS TO ISRAELI SOLDIERS

Each team is asked to write letters to Israeli soldiers. 5 points will be awarded for every letter written (maximum: 500 Pts .). Each person can write an infinite number of letters. The letters may include words of encouragement, words of gratitude, or simply a description of one's family. They can be about anything. Pictures are recommended. Letters received after Thursday, May $6^{\text {th }}, 11: 00 \mathrm{PM}$ will not be awarded with Color War points, but rather with heavenly points.

## SOCIAL MEDIA (150 Pts.)

Each team must post pictures from our Color War events to social media (Facebook, Instagram or twitter) with \#yijecolorwar. 1 point will be awarded for every picture posted of Color War events (maximum 150 points) Pictures must be posted by 11PM THURSDAY, May $6^{\text {th }}$. Additional pictures of Friday events (only) may be posted for points NO LATER THAN 6PM FRIDAY, May $7^{\text {th }}$.
