SHABBAT PARSHAT MIKEITZ SEVENTH DAY CHANUKAH 2 TEVET/DECEMBER 31

Light the Chanukah Menorah at home before lighting the Shabbat candles. Be careful to use enough oil (or light a large enough candle) to remain lit until 30 minutes after the appearance of three stars. There is a minhag to daven Mincha before lighting the Menorah, but one should not delay the welcoming of Shabbat because of this. One may not light Chanukah or Shabbat candles earlier than Plag HaMincha (3:40 PM).

Maftir reads from Numbers 7:48-53, ביום השביעי, until עמיהוד בן אלישמע בן עמייהוד. Haftarah is Zechariah 2:14-4:7. We do not say א-ל מלא א-ל, אב הרחמים, א-ל מלא א-ל. צדקתך צדק.

Youth Program

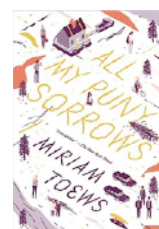
- ☆ Groups for children ages 3-12 begin at 10:15 AM, meeting in the Beit Midrash.
