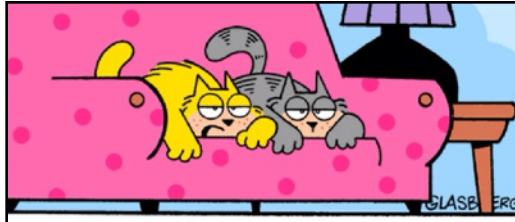

### Points To Ponder (Answers Below)

- ☆ (2nd aliyah) How does Yaakov allude to his mother and honor her in meeting her family?
- ☆ (4th aliyah) How does Reuven imitate his father in this aliyah?
- ☆ (5th aliyah) How do Lavan and Lavan's son differ in their attitude toward Yaakov and his impact on the family business? What implications does this have for macro economics in the 21st century?
- ☆ (7th aliyah) Bonus: Do Lavan and Yaakov come to an agreement? What evidence is there one way or another?

### Answers To Points To Ponder

- ☆ (2nd) He imitates his mother by watering Rachel's sheep, just like Rivkah watered Avraham's servants camels, Yaakov makes reference to that by reciprocating with Rachel's flock.
- ☆ (4th) He purchases the rights to Yaakov for his mother with flowers. Yaakov also invested in the future of his lineage with the soup he sold to Esav in Parshat Toldot.
- ☆ (5th) Lavan recognizes the success he's had with Yaakov running his company. The sons narrow their lens and only see Yaakov as taking what their father owned.
