Throughout the time of my attendance at the synagogue, and when entering and leaving, I will immediately and fully comply with all directions of synagogue staff.

Throughout the time of my attendance at the synagogue, and when entering and leaving, I will practise social distancing by strictly observing the rule of no more than one person per 4 square metres, and maintaining a physical distance of at least 1.5 metres from all other persons. This will also apply if I am called to the Bimah.

I warrant that the information I have provided is true and correct to the best of my knowledge, and that I have not knowingly provided information which is false, misleading or incomplete.

I understand that the synagogue, its office-bearers, clergy, staff and contractors, and other persons attending the service, will rely on the truth and accuracy of the information I have provided in this application in seeking to mitigate the risk of COVID-19 infection by community spread within the synagogue and its precincts.

If, between the time of submitting this application to the synagogue and the scheduled time of commencement of the service I wish to attend, my circumstances change in any way that would result in any information I have provided no longer being true, correct and complete, I will immediately notify the synagogue of full details of the changed circumstances.
