

## Earliest Time for Talis & Tefilin 5782

The *Mishna Berachos* 1:2 and *Talmud Berachos* 9b state that the earliest time for *Shema* is the time at which there is enough light to recognize a friend who is at a distance of four cubits. This time is known as "*Misheyakir*". *Shulchan Aruch Orach Chaim* (18:3 and 58:1) rules that *Misheyakir* is the earliest time for saying *brachos* on *Talis* and *Tefilin* as well. The exact time of *Misheyakir* is a matter of halachic debate. The times listed below are calculated for 50 minutes before sunrise in 85254 during the mid-winter.
