## Location

The Main Minyan, Children's Programming and Babysitting will all take place in an our shul facility at **13402 N Scottsdale Rd, Suite #B140-150**. We will have the benefit of the services of off-duty police, professional babysitters, and lots of staff dedicated to making your Yontif experience great with ample space and facilities for multiple groups, under the supervision of paid staff, community teachers, and parent volunteers.

## Childcare and Babysitting

On Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur, we will have expanded programming for children until 1:30 PM. A complete schedule will be forwarded. Previous years' highlights have included: four different age groups, snacks, shofar blowing in shul, games, visits from the rabbis, Yom Kippur lunch, and age-appropriate davening. All childcare and babysitting will take place at the High Holiday location, divided for use by multiple groups. Parent volunteers are needed.
