# Kiddushim to mark your simcha

It is customary at the Great Synagogue to mark a family simcha by sponsoring a kiddush on Shabbat morning, for your guests and the rest of the congregation, catered by the Women's Auxiliary. There are a number of different options to allow you to choose a kiddush which suits your budget and the number of guests you are expecting.

#### KIDDUSH 1: Sponsored at \$820

This Kiddush will serve around 120 people and consists of:

\* Herring and savoury biscuits \* Olives and cucumbers \* Dips with vegetables \* Cocktail fried fish \* Fruit \* Cakes \* Chips \* Lollies \* Wine \* Soft Drinks

### KIDDUSH 2: Sponsored at \$1220

All the above plus:

\* Fried gefilte fish balls **or** \*Savouries on bread rounds including smoked salmon, eggs and onions and chopped herring or tuna and vegetable spread

#### KIDDUSH 3: Sponsored at \$1290

This Kiddush will serve 250 people and consists of all the items in Kiddush 1 in extra quantities plus:

\* Fried fish pieces \* Boiled Gefilte fish \* Stuffed eggs

## KIDDUSH 4: Sponsored at \$1650

This Kiddush includes all the items in Kiddush 3 plus savouries on bread rounds including smoked salmon, eggs and onions and chopped herring or salmon and vegetable spread
