





## *Programs and Events in the Jewish Community*



Dr. Barbara Lauer-Listhaus completed a doctorate in Clinical Psychology at Yeshiva University Ferkauf Graduate School of Psychology and post-doctoral training in Adolescent and Adult Neuropsychology. She works in a private practice in New Jersey with children, adolescents and adults with a wide range of mental health issues. She serves as a consultant and board member for several special needs organizations, and is on the Board of Ferkauf Graduate School of Psychology.

Her new book, *Flavors for Everyone* provides an insider's view - by a neuropsychologist who is the mother of a special needs son - into the complex problems that families face when raising children with different abilities and personalities, and offers practical solutions for families to implement.

Dr. Lauer-Listhaus speaks internationally on topics relating to marital and sibling issues and the impact of divorce on children. She is the mother of four adult children and has two grandchildren.
