



The Hon. Kathleen Weil is the newly appointed Quebec Minster of Relations with English-speaking Quebeckers. A member of the Liberal Party of Quebec, Ms. Weil has represented the riding of NDG since 2008. She is a past Administrator of the Montreal Children's Hospital, former President and CEO of the Foundation of Greater Montreal, and the former Montreal Minister of Immigration, Diversity and Inclusiveness.

The Hon. Myra Freeman has the distinction of being the first Jew to be appointed Lieutenant Governor of a Canadian province and the first woman to hold that office in Nova Scotia. Ms. Freeman is a member of the Order of Canada, received the Woman of Action Humanitarian Award from the Canadian Israel Research Foundation, and was recognized as one of Canada's 100 Outstanding Women by the Richard Ivy School of Business. When she was Lt. Governor of Nova Scotia, she was notable for the high Jewish profile she maintained, and arranged that when she and her family lived in Government House, the kitchens were kosher.

Dr. Victoria Kaspi is an internationally renowned astrophysicist and professor of physics at McGill University. Dr. Kaspi is the first woman to win the \$1 million Gerhard Herzog Gold Medal, Canada's top science prize, and the first woman to be appointed Director of the McGill Space institute. Among her many honours and awards, she received the Prix Marie-Victorin (the highest Science award in Quebec), and she was made a fellow of the Royal Society of Canada. In 2016, Dr. Kaspi was appointed as a companion of the Order of Canada.

Dr. Louise Pilote is a Professor of Medicine and James McGill Chair at Mcgill University and the Director of Internal Medicine at the MUHC. An internationally recognized clinician and scientist, Dr. Pilote is an innovative leader in targeting and fighting cardiovascular disease, especially in women. In recognition of her pioneering research in cardiovascular disease and access to care for patients with congenital heart failure, Dr. Pilote was named as the 2016 Woman of Distinction


