The Great Jewish Books Course

In memory of Dr. Mark Wainberg ז"ל

Explore the Lasting Impact of Monumental Jewish Works

This course will survey 20 of the most influential Rabbis and their Works that have shaped the Jewish world as we know it. Starting with "Teacher of all of Israel" - Rashi, and continuing through Modern Times, each individual class will focus on excerpts of major themes, biographical sketches and historical context of the books and authors that have forged the link between the Torah itself and our lives today.

Every session will be accompanied by a handout that includes a class outline, selections from that week's Book, and other relevant charts. Binders will be available for purchase.

Classes will involve studying traditional texts (available in Hebrew and English), the investigation of key themes and the presentation of avenues for further study.

ALL LECTURES OF THE GREAT JEWISH BOOKS COURSE WILL TAKE PLACE AT TBDJ ON MONDAY NIGHTS FROM 7:45-9:00PM.
