Born in Houston, Texas, Ari made Aliyah after high school and served as a sharpshooter in the Golani Infantry Brigade. Having founded the premier English speaking podcast network in Israel, Ari is a respected advocate for Israel, both domestically and internationally with appearances on CNN, Fox News, BBC, and many other international outlets.

In 2015, with his partner and IDF commander Rabbi Jeremy Gimpel, Ari embarked on this greatest mission of his life, founding the Arugot Farm and Retreat Center on the southeastern tip of Judea. In just a few short years, the center has transformed from being barren and desolate desert mountains into a Garden of Eden-like oasis with vineyards, sheep, a nearly completed retreat center, thousands of fruit trees, and so much more. The center hosts thousands of tourists every year, and also serves as headquarters for TheLandofIsrael.Com Network.

Ari lives with his wife Shaena on a mountaintop overlooking Masada and the Dead Sea on the Arugot Farms.
