Aspects of Mourning During the "Three Weeks"

- No weddings are held. However, engagement ceremonies are permitted.
- We do not listen to music.
- We avoid all public celebrations -- especially those which involve dancing and musical accompaniment.
- We avoid exciting and entertaining trips and activities. (Kaf HaChaim - OC 551:41)
- No haircuts or shaving. Fingernails may be clipped up until the week in which Tisha B'Av falls. If one will suffer a financial loss by not shaving, it is permitted to do so until the nine days begin.
- We do not say the blessing She-hecheyanu on new food or clothes, except on Shabbat.
