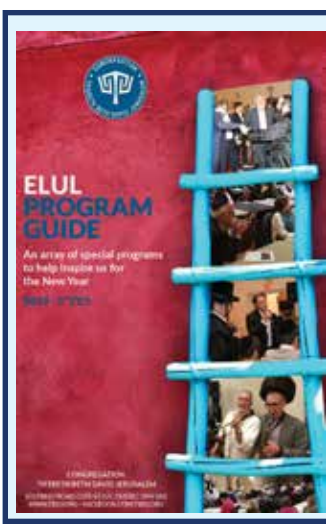

Rabbi Pinchas Landis is a dynamic and fascinating speaker and teacher, specializing in the areas of Jewish Inspiration and Jewish History. He is currently the Education Director for Partners In Torah, in Cleveland, Ohio, prior to which he served as a Congregational Rabbi in Cincinnati (Gulf Manor Synagogue).

Throughout this time he became more interested and aware of traditional Judaism. Rabbi Landis has since spent a total of nine years learning at Yeshiva University, Ohr Somayach, and the Ner Israel Rabbinical College. He has also done postgraduate work towards a Masters in Community Counseling at Johns Hopkins University. He enjoys rock climbing, reading business books, working out, graphic and web design, and playing with anything electronic. Rabbi Landis will be joined by his wife Nomi, and four of their five beautiful children.
