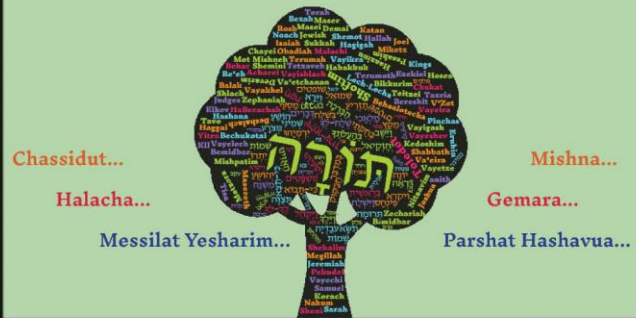

Rabbi Reuven Bulka has been the spiritual leader of Ottawa's Congregation Machzikei Hadas since 1967. He received semikhah from New York's Rabbi Jacob Joseph Rabbinical Seminary in 1965, and in 1971 he received his PhD from the University of Ottawa. In addition to writing more than 30 books and countless articles on religion, health and psychology, he is the host of "Sunday Night with Rabbi Bulka" on radio and a frequent contributor to the newspaper column called "Ask the Religion Experts." In 2010, Rabbi Bulka received Ottawa's "Key to the City" and in 2013 he was appointed to the Order of Canada.

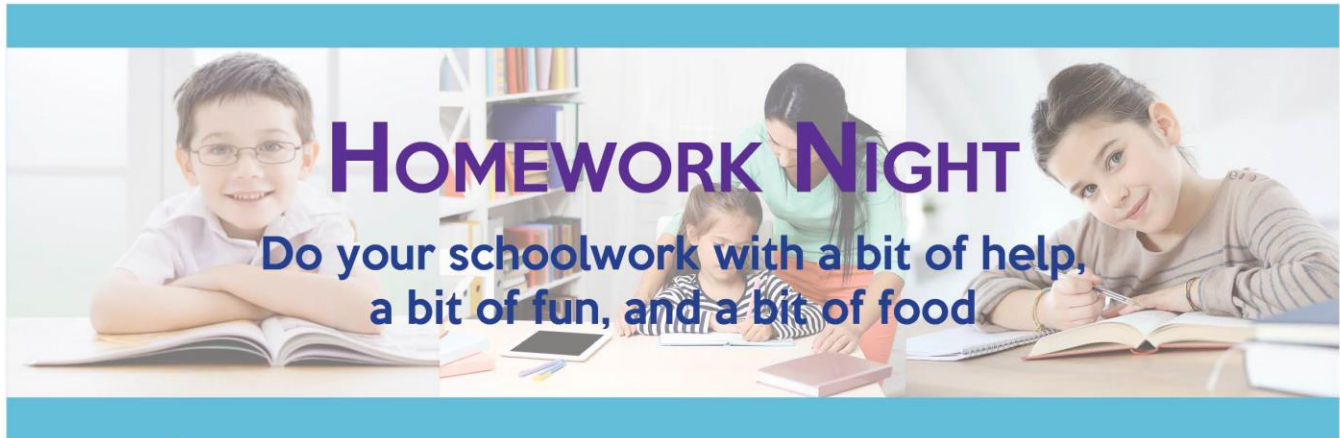
