Lenny Roth, a member of the Israeli Consulate's Speakers Bureau in Miami, speaks frequently on topics relating to Israel, the political and economic climate in the Middle East, energy security and environmental sustainability.

This book presents the issues and challenges of Modern Orthodox Judaism in America from the 1920s to the 1960s and discusses the economic, social, and political influences that impacted on its development. This is the story of the renaissance of American Modern Orthodoxy, from the disorganization of the older Orthodoxy to the new spirit of confidence that emerged after World War Two.

Rabbi Neuwirth serves as Rabbi of Ohel Ari (Minyan Chadash) in Ra'annana. He is the founder of "Beit Hillel – Attentive Spiritual Leadership", an organization that strives to magnify the voice of centrist mainstream Judaism and stop religious extremism in Israel.

A rabbi, teacher, former hi-tech Chief Technology Officer, and captain in the Israeli Navy Special Forces, he received his Smicha from the Chief Rabbinate of Israel and a B.A. in Mathematics and Computer Science from Bar Ilan University.


