May 28: Shabbaton with Lenny Roth

Lenny Roth, a member of the Israeli Consulate's Speakers Bureau in Miami, speaks frequently on topics relating to Israel, the political and economic climate in the Middle East, energy security and environmental sustainability.

Lenny grew up in Montreal, attended McGill University and Harvard Law School, and now serves as adjunct professor of Business Law and Ethics at Nova Southeastern University in Fort Lauderdale and at Ben Gurion University of the Negev.

He serves as a member of AIPAC's Congressional Club, and co-chairs the Florida Congressional Committee, a bipartisan PAC that distributes over \$100,000 per year to pro-Israel members of the US Senate and House of Representatives.

Rabbi Neuwirth serves as Rabbi of Ohel Ari (Minyan Chadash) in Ra'annana. He is the founder of "Beit Hillel – Attentive Spiritual Leadership", an organization that strives to magnify the voice of centrist mainstream Judaism and stop religious extremism in Israel.






