Although the Ninth of Av falls on Shabbat this year and the fast is delayed, we are permitted to have wine and meat at our Shabbat meals.

We are permitted to have meat at Seudah Shleesheet as well.

Shabbat, August 13:

6:00pm - Mincha

Following Mincha it is customary to have Seudah Shleesheet at home with one's family and not in a large crowd. None of the restrictions of the traditional Seudah Mafseket apply (sitting on the floor, eating an egg, etc.), and one may eat meat or drink wine.

8:04pm - fast begins 8:53pm - Shabbat concludes

It is customary to say the words "Baruch Hamavdil Bayn Kodesh L'Chol" after Shabbat prior to changing into non-leather footwear for the fast. Due to the fast, Havdalah is not recited on Saturday night.

9:15pm - Ma'ariv and Megillat Eichah Rabbi Freundlich will speak briefly following Maariv prior to Eichah.

Sunday, August 14:

8:00am - Shacharit and Explanatory Kinnot 2:00pm - Early Mincha 7:30pm - Late Mincha / Ma'ariv 8:42pm - conclusion of fast / Havdala

Following the fast, Havdalah is recited on a cup of wine (the candle and spices are not used) and there is a custom to recite Kiddush Levana. The prohibitions of the nine days no longer apply, except we wait until Monday to eat meat and drink wine. In a year when the fast falls on the actual weekday (not delayed by Shabbat), we observe the prohibitions of the nine days until the following day at noon.


