The lectures will deal with the story of Modern Orthodox Judaism in America from 1920 to 1960 by looking at the activities and involvements of one of its leaders, Rabbi Dr. Leo Jung, who served as a bridge between the old Eastern-European Orthodoxy that did not develop in America beyond the immigrant generation and the Modern Orthodoxy of today.

Topics include: Early influences, the confrontation with America, the Conservative problem, and position on Zionism.

Part 2 - Modern Orthodoxy in the Thirties and Forties

Part 3 - Modern Orthodoxy in the Fifties

Monday, Sept. 26, 2016 at 8:00pm

Topics include: Renewal and reinvigoration, the gap with Conservative movement, movement to the right, and broader study of the topic.

Dr. Ilan Dinstein, a member of Ben-Gurion University's Department of Psychology and the Zlowtowski Center for Neuroscience, has established Israel's first neurophysiological lab at the University.

Dr. Dinstein's research aims to diagnose Autism Spectrum Disorder in the very young. Affecting 1 of every 68 children born in Canada, autism is generally diagnosed by behavioural criteria which may not be evident until precious time has been lost; earlier diagnosis leads to earlier treatment options.
