What is the “Shinshinim Program”?

The Shnat Sherut (.ש.ש Shinshinim) Service Year Program places Israeli high school graduate volunteers in Jewish communities abroad for a year prior to enrolling for their military service. The goal of the program is to encourage interaction among young Jews through dialogue. While abroad, they live with host families in the community. Service Year Shlichim (at least two per community) volunteer in local Jewish day schools and supplementary schools, community centres, synagogues and other places. They actively participate in informal Jewish and Hebrew educational programs and activities, while conveying a sophisticated, personal, and relevant image of Israel to their students.

We are looking for host families from the Jewish community who will be able to host a “Shinshin” for a period of 5 months (between the end of August to January or from January to June). If you want to open your home and heart to Israel and if you are looking for a deep and special connection to Israel – join the growing community of host families in Montreal.
