An Important Message from Bar Mitzvah Joshua Hutman:





Dear Family & Friends,

In honour of becoming a Bar Mitzvah in June, I will be organizing a book drive for the Jewish General Hospital's Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU).

I was born at 24 weeks and weighed 495 grams (slightly over 11b). I was on a ventilator for 104 days and my mom held me for the very first time when I was almost 2 months old.

When babies are born prematurely, they are placed in incubators. Often babies need ventilators and they are connected with wires to many machines. This makes interacting with them impossible. Not being able to have this basic connection to their infants can make parents feel helpless and scared.

My goal is to start a reading program in the NICU and supply parents with <u>new</u> books which they can read to their babies even when they are too fragile to hold. Research has shown that reading to babies is good for language development. It also enables parents to bond with their babies. It gives parents a chance to do something "normal" when they are unable to care for their infants.
