Wednesdays at 11:30am in the TBDJ Library

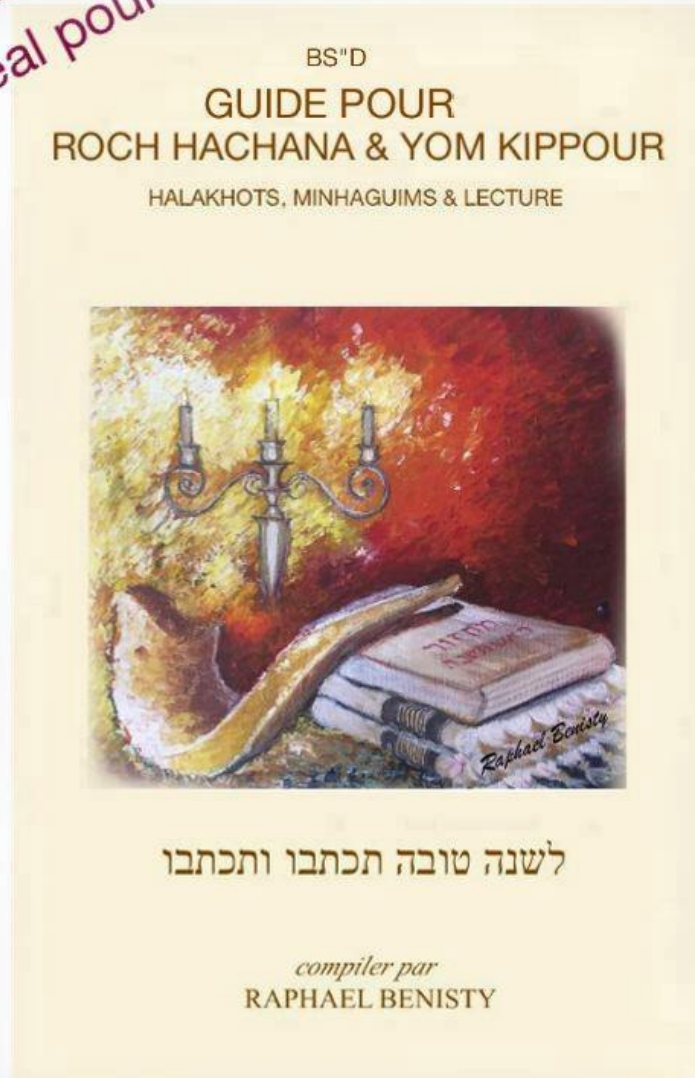
