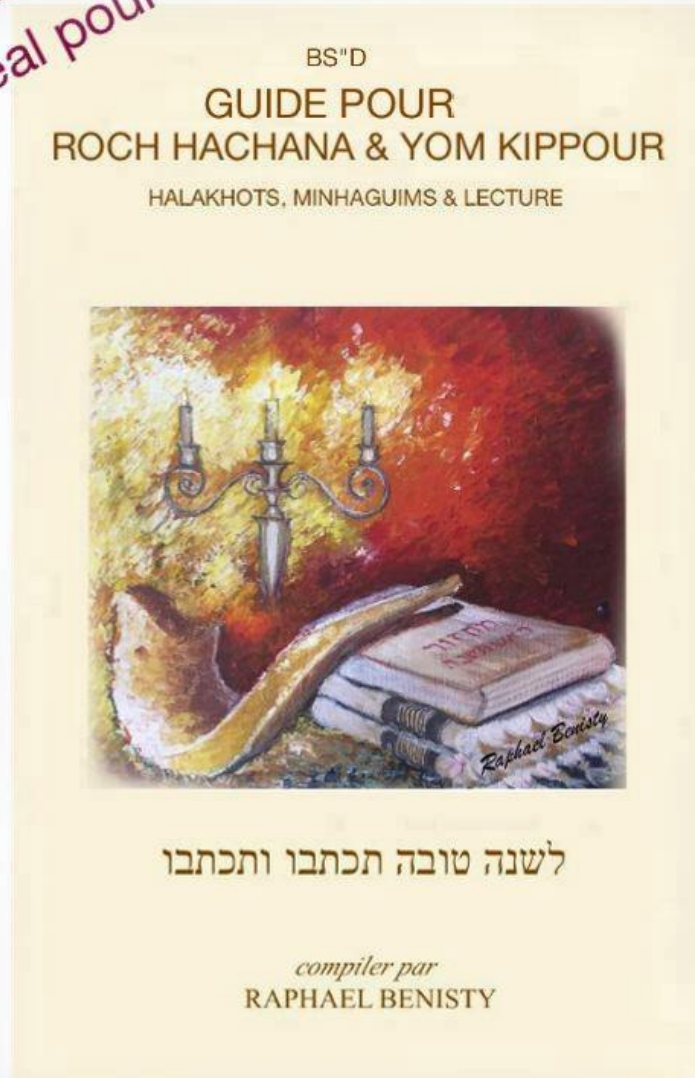
The Kaddish Circle
