She is one of today's most acclaimed Jewish educators and a leader in redrawing the landscape of Torah leadership and scholarship for women. Together with her husband, noted halachic authority Rabbi Yehuda Henkin, Rabbanit Henkin created the unique role of Yoatzot Halacha, experts in women's health and Jewish law, who have since addressed more than 300,000 halachic questions from across the world. Rabbanit Henkin was awarded Israel's prestigious Agrest Prize for innovative religious education.
