For most of the 1990s Gorfinkel guided the Batman


coordinating publications, licensing and productions for the DC Universe.

ABOVE AND BEYOND

In 1948, a group of Jewish American World War II pilots volunteered to fight for Israel in the War of Independence. This ragtag band of brothers not only turned the tide of the war, preventing the possible annihilation of Israel at the very moment of its birth, but also laid the groundwork for the Israeli Air Force. "Above and Beyond" brings together new interviews with pilots from the 1948 War, as well as with leading scholars and statesmen including Shimon Peres, to tell an extraordinary, little-known tale that has ramifications even today.



NUMBERED

An estimated 400,000 numbers were tattooed in Auschwitz and its subcamps. "Numbered" is an explosive, highly-visual and emotional cinematic journey guided by testimonies provided by Holocaust survivors. The film documents the dark context in which these tattoos were injected, as well as the meaning the numbers took on in the years following the war. In fact, the documentary's main protagonists are the numbers themselves - as each evolves and becomes both a personal and collective symbol for the survivors from 1940 to the present day.
