Shabbat Shalom Anshei TBDJ!

The opening verses of Parashat Vayakhel, the Torah portion of the week, discuss our holy Shabbos, the day of the week that we look forward to for so many reasons: Shul, family, friends, good food, rest...to name a few...

One way to keep our Shabbos spirits elevated is to celebrate Kabbalat Shabbat, the opening prayers of our Friday evening service, with song. This segment of the service features six chosen psalms from the Book of Tehillim which symbolize the six days of our week. The service moves on to L'cha Dodi which culminates in welcoming the Shabbos queen through song.
