Boaz, meanwhile, had gone up to the gate and sat down there. Just then, the redeemer of whom Boaz had spoken passed by. He said, “come over, sit down here, ploni almoni...” Rus 4:1

There was a redeemer closer to Rus to perform the levirate marriage whose name was Tov. The Megillah does not record his name, but rather refers to him as ploni almoni (Mr. Anonymous). Tov had valid reasons and concerns as to why he didn't want to marry Rus, so why should he be punished, and his name not be mentioned? The answer is, maybe he didn't do anything wrong, but he didn't do anything right either, by therefore letting an opportunity of a lifetime slip through his fingers. Tov could have been the father of the Davidic dynasty and Melech Hamashiach. Instead, he did nothing, and now he is Mr. Nobody and Boaz grabbed the opportunity and earned eternal merit. The message we learn from here is that every so often in life opportunities arise that really could very positively change our lives and bring us great spiritual merit. But we have excuses – I don't have the time, I don't think I am qualified, maybe next year, etc. The lesson is that when opportunity knocks, especially spiritual

- *Say Shmone Esreih for Shalosh Regalim – say inserts for Shavuot*

Friday Morning

- *Schacharis: 9:00 AM*
- *Say Hameir Laaretz (after Yishtabach and Bracha Yotzer Or)*
- *Say Shmone Esreih for Shalosh Regalim – say inserts for Shavuot*
- *Say full Hallel*
- *Do not say Vayehi Binsoa and Berich Shmei (the prayers for taking out the Torah)*
- *Note: It is appropriate to read the Torah reading and the Haftorah during the day; it is optional to read Akdamos*
- *Akdomos – p. 714 in Art Scroll Siddur*
- *Parsha for First Day Shavuot: Bachodesh Hashlishi and Aseres Hadibros – p. 400 in Stone Chumash; Maftir (U'vyom Habikurim) – p. 892 in Stone Chumash*
- *Haftorah for First Day Shavuot: p. 1228 in Stone Chumash.*
- *Say Ashrei (No Yekum Purkan, no Av Harachamim)*
- *Do not say Mizmor L'David and U'venuha Yomar*
- *Say Mussaf Shmoeni Esreih for Shalosh Regalim – say inserts for Shavuot*

Friday Afternoon/Evening

- *Mincha: 7:00 PM*
- *Candle Lighting: 7:25/7:49 PM*
- *For Kabbalas Shabbos only say Mizmor Shir L'Yom Hashabbas and Hashem Malach*
- *No Bameh Madlikin – Go directly to Maariv*
- *Just before Shmonei Esreih say V'Shomroo (for Shabbos) and then Vayedaber (for Yom Tov)*
- *Say Shmone Esreih for Shalosh Regalim – say inserts for Shabbos and Shavuot*
- *Say Vayechulu after Shemonah Esrei, but do not say the next three paragraphs.*

Shabbos Morning

- *Schacharis: 9:00 AM*
- *Say Hakol Yoducha (after Yishtabach and Bracha Yotzer Or)*
- *Say Shmone Esreih for Shalosh Regalim – say inserts for Shabbos and Shavuot*
- *Say full Hallel*
- *Do not say Vayehi Binsoa and Berich Shmei (the prayers for taking out the Torah)*

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- *Note: It is appropriate to read Megillas Rus, the Torah reading and the Haftorah during the day*
- *Megillas Rus – p. 1269 in Stone Chumash*
- *Parsha for Second Day Shavuos: Aser T'Aser – p. 1012 in Stone Chumash; Maftir (U'vYom Habikurim) – p. 892 in Stone Chumash*
- *Haftorah for Second Day Shavuos: p. 1230 in Stone Chumash Chumash.*
- *Say first paragraph of Yekum Purkan; do not say the next two paragraphs*
- *Yizkor is said at this point*
- *Say Av Harachamim after Yizkor, followed by Ashrei*
- *Do not say Mizmor L'David and U'venuha Yomar*
- *Say Mussaf Shmoeni Esreih for Shalosh Regolim – say inserts for Shabbos and Shavuos*

Shabbos Afternoon

- *Mincha: 7:00 PM,*
- *Say Shmone Esreih for Shalosh Regolim – say inserts for Shabbos and Shavuos*
- *Do not say Tzidkuscha Tzedek*
- *Seudah shlishis*
- *Say Regular Maariv Shmonei Esreih before Havdalah*
- *Regular Havdalah (wine, fire, and spice): 8:52 PM*
