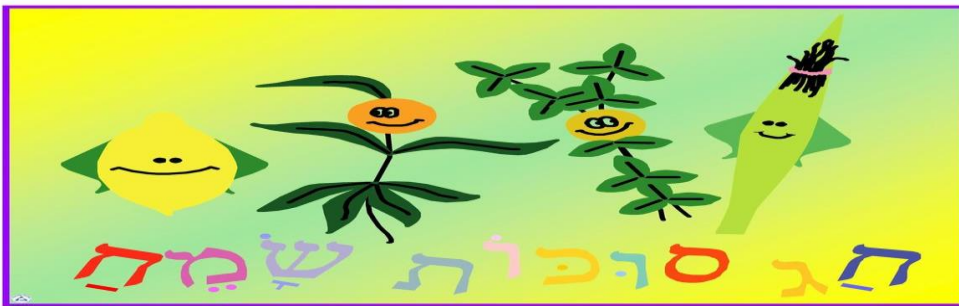

**Please complete the census in one of 3 ways:**

- 1) By calling toll-free 7 days a week **between 7am and 2am EST 1-844-330-2020**;
- 2) by logging into [www.2020census.gov](http://www.2020census.gov); or
- 3) by speaking with the Census representative when they come to your home.

**It is quick and easy – taking less than 10 minutes – and all responses and personal information are protected by federal law. By completing the Census, which only happens every 10 years, our community is ensured to receive our share of federal funds and representation in Congress**

**Eruv Bal Harbour:** While the Eruv in Surfside includes both walking paths, in Bal Harbour the Eruv only includes the inner (western) walking path. The pier at Haulover Cut is not included. We would like to emphasize that every Erev Shabbos, individuals should call the Eruv Hotline to make sure that the Eruv is operational prior to carrying on Shabbos. The number is 305-866-ERUV (3788).
