Art, Forgery and Loot in the Naziera is a topic that has come recently on the news as art repatriation occurs. With calculated dedication the Nazis emptied state museums, art galleries, and private collections as they went occupying different countries. The Nazis created a task force to do so, called The ERR headed by Alfred Rosenberg. In 2012, the apartment of Cornelius Gurlitt in Munich was searched by the authorities. A cache of around 2000 works of art was found, this murky story surfaced from the chaotic times of WWII.
