However, there is a caveat that's very important to remember -- this only applies on condition that the Mitzvah or good deed is done quietly, without fanfare, in fulfillment of the verse, והצנע לכם עם אלקיך, "And you shall walk humbly with your G-d" (6:8 Michah). When a Mitzvah becomes public knowledge, it loses much of its potency to silence the prosecuting angels.
