The more a person puts his trust in G-d and looks to him for his security, the more blessing he will receive. King David describes himself in Psalms (131:12) כגמול עלי אמו "Like a suckling infant upon his mother." He was entirely dependent on G-d just as a nursing baby is entirely dependent upon his mother. One of the interesting features of nursing is that the milk supply is dependent upon the child. As long as the infant is interested in nursing, the mother's body produces milk. But once he is no longer interested in his mother's milk it ceases to be available. The same is true of our reliance on G-d -- the greater the reliance on G-d, the greater the "supply" of blessing there will eventually be.
