One day Rav Shalom was approached by Chaim Cohen, a philanthropist who was a loyal supporter of many worthy tzedakah projects. Mr Cohen got straight to the point. He said to Rav Shalom, "last week I invested in a deal that I thought would net me a profit of \$50,000 in a very short period of time. Unfortunately, it looks like this deal is going sour. I asked myself, do the poor have to suffer because I made a bad investment? Had I made a \$50,000 profit I would have given maaser (1/10 to charity) to tzedakah." With that he hands a \$5,000 check to Rav Shalom. This is what you call a real baal tzedakah!
