Dear Congregant,

High Holy Days are such a special time at PJTC. In addition to the beautiful music, important self-reflection, and meaningful prayer, it is a wonderful opportunity for our community to just be together. Longtime friends reconnect while our newer members begin to form the relationships that make our synagogue experience special. And, collectively, we lift our voices and are spiritually linked with countless generations of our people across the globe.

Many of you have shared that the High Holy Day fundraising appeal detracts from the sanctity of the holidays and the quality of our time together as a community. Until now, the High Holy Day appeal has persisted at PJTC year after year because the money raised is crucial to our ability to operate the synagogue. However, we have listened to your feedback and are trying a new fundraising approach that we believe will allow us to meet our fundraising needs without diminishing our High Holy Day experience.

This year, there will be no appeal speech from the *bimah* or active fundraising during the High Holy Days. Instead, we are relying on everyone in our community to respond generously to the fundraising requests you will see both before and after the High Holy Days to help keep our synagogue vibrant and financially healthy.

Why an Annual Appeal?

Our membership dues only provide one-third of PJTC's annual revenue. The resulting budget gap can only be met if we all make PJTC part of our *zedakah*, charitable contributions (which are, of course, in addition to our membership dues).

How are donations to the Annual Appeal used? Some ways we allocate these funds include:

- * To pay for security at services, religious school and community events
- * To support youth activities including USY and Kadima
- * To provide music, speakers and scholars at services and events
- * To supplement dues when members experience financial hardship
- * To offer tuition assistance to LBSRS families who demonstrate financial need
- * To underwrite community activities, including Second Night Seder, Shabbat Kiddush and Onegs, Adult Education, basketball and juggling
- * To ensure access to everyday needs like air conditioning and internet

Who needs to contribute?

- * In addition to our Annual Appeal financial goal, we are setting the lofty goal of 100% participation by all PJTC families/members.
- * If every PJTC family donates only \$36 monthly for twelve months (starting in August) to the Annual Appeal we will meet our financial goal. If you can give more than \$36/month, please do so!
- * If \$36/month is out of reach, please consider an Annual Appeal donation in any amount that is meaningful to you. Your participation matters!

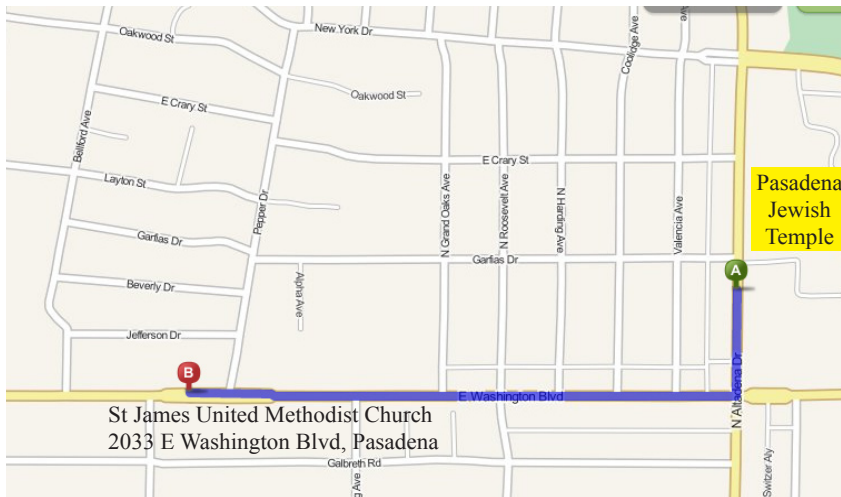
Parking Reservation for Handicapped Congregants & Shomrei Zahav

Parking on the PJTC campus during the High Holy Days is limited to members who are handicapped or are Shomrei Zahav (Golden Guardian donors). These parking spaces are available by reservation only, and will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis, one per family.

If all PJTC campus parking spaces are full, members are welcome to **drive in and drop off** those needing easy access to the synagogue and/or utilize the offsite parking and shuttle service described below.

High Holy Days Youth Programming

In our effort to make the High Holy Days a full family experience, we have created a varied, multi-experiential program for children 2 years to 12 years.

Your children will have the opportunity to experience parts of the community worship service as well as interactive, meaningful and creative activities designed for each grade level and led by our talented Religious School teachers.

- Kindershule includes a tefillah (prayer) experience, as well as an exploration of the High Holy Days through art, story, music and movement.

Jr Congregation (3rd - 7th graders)

- Jr Congregation will include a tefillah (prayer) experience and electives. Electives will involve the themes of the day through different modes. After tefillah (prayer), students engage with the holiday through different activities planned by our LBSRS faculty.

Online Pre-registration is required for all youth programs.

(Programs may be cancelled if not enough children are pre-registered, minimum of 5.)
