All fully vaccinated (two weeks after the final shot) individuals can choose to attend minyanim, shiurim and Shul programs without being masked and without socially distancing. This assumes responsible behavior and full honesty, including notifying us if tested positive for COVID. We also appreciate that some people may choose to mask, even if vaccinated, as suggested by the CDC, but not mandated locally. Everyone should consult their own healthcare provider for their particular concerns.

Individuals, including children, who are not fully vaccinated must wear a mask and socially distance themselves from anyone outside of their family group. We reserve the right to request proof of vaccination.

We continue to offer an outdoor Shabbat morning minyan, and as demand requires, we may consider adding additional minyanim.

Please respect the safety and comfort level choices of your fellow members.

If you're not feeling well for any reason, DON'T come to Shul. Anyone with medical questions should consult their own health care provider for guidance for their particular concerns.

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
