Kol Israel Fall Memorial on Sunday, September 24th at 2:00 pm: Officiated by Rabbi Richard Block of Temple Tifereth Israel, we will be commemorating the six million Jews who perished in the Holocaust. Kol Israel will also be dedicating the Historical Marker awarded by the Ohio History Connection. The commemoration will take place at Zion Memorial Park, 5461 Northfield Road in Bedford Heights.
