Summer Recipe Corner!

sarah@greenroadsynagogue.org for a chance to be featured in our Weekly! <u>This Weeks Recipe:</u> Zucchini Vichyssoise by The Hoenig's (adapted from Ina Garten)

This recipe is a perfect start to a summer Shabbat lunch! Fresh and local zucchini and leeks add a special touch.

1 Tbsp Earth Balance, 1 Tbsp olive oil

5 cups of chopped leeks- white & light green parts (4-8 leeks)

4 cups of chopped and peeled Yukon Gold potatoes (approx. 5 medium)

3 cups of chopped zucchini (approx. 2 zucchini)

1 1/2 quarts of vegetable stock, 1/2 cup of soy or almond milk

1 tsp of kosher salt, 1/2 tsp of freshly ground black pepper

Fresh chives and/ or crumbled Terra chips for garnish

Directions: Heat the Earth Balance and oil in a large stockpot, add the leeks, and sauté over medium-low heat for 5 minutes. Add the potatoes, zucchini, vegetable stock, salt, and pepper. Bring to a boil and then lower the heat and simmer for 30 minutes. Cool and then process with a hand blender (or regular blender).Add the soy or almond milk and season to taste. Garnish before serving.

Can be made two days ahead. If the soup is too thick add more soy or almond milk Can be made dairy by using butter and heavy cream.
