This Weeks Recipe: Corn & Bean Salad by Sarah Ehrenreich

3-4 ears of corn grilled (boiled is fine or 1 can) and cut off of the cob

1 can of black beans, rinsed

1/2 of a large green pepper, pith removed and diced. 1/4 of a large red onion, diced.

1/2 cup of pickles (either Osem Israeli or Trader Joes Hot & Spicy) cut into small pieces

Freshly ground black pepper to taste. Mix together and serve chilled
