This Weeks Recipe: Blueberry Coconut Soup with Lime by Edith Tesler

Makes 6 servings and can easily be doubled or even tripled

3 cups of blueberries (can be fresh, frozen, or a mix)

3/4 cup of sugar (depending on the sweetness of the blueberries you can use less)

1/2 cup of water; grated zest of 1 lime; 1/4 cup fresh lime juice

15 oz can of lite coconut milk and 1/3 cup of flaked coconut, toasted as garnish

In a medium sauce pan add the blueberries, sugar, water, lime zest and lime juice and bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer for 10 minutes. Transfer to a large bowl to chill. Pour the mixture into a blender and blend with coconut milk until smooth and light. Transfer back to the large bowl and chill before serving. Garnish with toasted coconut.
