INFORMATION REGARDING ACCESS TO THE BUILDING

There will be a single code for weekday access that will be announced at the conclusion of all minyanim. The code will be active during the following times:

- Shortly before Shacharit until shortly before Shacharit ends
- Shortly before Mincha until shortly before Maariv ends
- Monday through Thursday, shortly before the start of learning until shortly before learning ends
- This code is entered on the keypad outside of the building to the left of the door
- You will not be able to use the code to access the building at any other time
- To enter the shul during regular office hours, you will need to buzz into the building.

There is a separate code for Shabbat. This code will also be announced in shul. The code will be active during the following times:

- Shortly before Kabbalat Shabbat on Friday until shortly before it ends
- Shortly before Hashkama on Shabbat morning until shortly before the main minyan ends
- Shortly before Mincha until shortly before Havdalah

Please be aware that no one should be accessing the building prior to programming or lingering after programs have ended. We have put our code system in place for the safety of our community, but the codes are only half of the equation. We rely on you, our membership, to work with us. Without this team effort, the integrity of the system is compromised, and the safety of our congregation is at stake. Thank you for helping us to maintain the safety of our community.
