FAST OF THE FIRST BORN

Passover Eve is a traditional Fast for the First Born in recognition of the Jewish firstborns being spared the plague in Egypt. By attending/participating in a Siyum, the completion of a Tractate of Talmud on Friday morning, April 22, the first born are exempt from fasting. Rabbi Langer will conduct the Siyum. The Service starts at 7:00 AM.
