# Online Membership Renewals

We are pleased to announce that you can now pay your membership on line via a secure form without the hassle of writing cheques or the need to drop off your contribution.

Simply follow these instructions:

1. Please ensure that the synagogue has your correct e-mail address linked to your file
2. Download the Beth Emeth Bais Yehuda app from your provider (it's free!)
3. Alternatively, go to [beby.org](http://beby.org) and go to login. (Top-right of page)
4. Enter your e-mail address
5. Select "forgot password" and you will be given an opportunity to set your password
6. Your account profile and balance will come up.
7. Select submit a payment.
8. Follow the prompts to complete your payment.
9. Payment schedules may be arranged. Please note that your last payment must be made prior to May 31st, 2019.
- 10. Please review your profile for any errors/and or omissions and correct/update your online profile before proceeding to pay your statement.**



# Requesting Your Tickets

**Your membership at Beth Emeth includes High Holy Day tickets but you must indicate your request to us.**

Regular Family Membership includes:

one male & one female set of adult tickets

Single Head of Household Membership includes: one set of adult tickets

Tickets are required for **all** wishing to enter the Synagogue premises.

**NON TRANSFERABLE**

Tickets are **NON TRANSFERABLE**.  
Please **DO NOT** share your tickets.

## Tickets/Passes for Children

### Main Sanctuary

Children under the age of 17 may enter the Main Sanctuary **ONLY** with a Sanctuary ticket, which may be **purchased for \$30**.  
Children aged 18-25 may enter the Main Sanctuary **ONLY** with a Sanctuary ticket, which may be **purchased for \$72**.

### Other Services/Programmes

Children (aged 0-25) wishing to attend all other services or programs must obtain a **YOUTH PASS** at no additional cost.  
If your children (under age 13) wish to attend the Youth Programs you must provide names and ages when requesting Youth Passes.

## Tickets for Parents

Members may purchase tickets for their parents at a cost of \$250.00 each.

(Parents must belong to another synagogue or live out of town)

Please Note: Receipts for these tickets are issued to the member only (and **NOT** to the parents).

**Add all required information to your renewal statement and return to the office with your payment.**


# How To Pay Your Membership

In order for High Holy Day tickets to be issued, your membership **MUST** be in good standing.

*\*Interac: if you pay the entire amount at one time you can use Interac in person only.*



## Important Notes:

- Your first payment **must** be current at time of renewal.
- Payment by cheque to a maximum of 6 cheques only
- Credit card payments may be made to a **maximum of 10 installments**
- Your final payment **must** be made before May 31, 2019
- There are no pre-authorized payments by cheque permitted.
- Any payment made in the 2018 calendar year will be tax receipted for 2018.


## Parking Your Car

## **MAIN SERVICE — IN THE SANCTUARY**

**8:00 AM ROSH HASHANAH | 8:30 AM YOM KIPPUR**

In the main service, you can find three or four generations of a family sitting together, from little children to grandparents or great-grandparents.

This is a full, traditional service with age-old and contemporary melodies led by Cantor David Guber and choral group. Rabbi Howard Morrison offers brief explanations throughout the service as well as delivers a formal sermon, which relates to our traditions to the challenges of contemporary Jewish life.

One of the joys of a large synagogue service is that you feel as if you are praying with the entire people of Israel. Experience the spiritual thrill of standing with thousands of your fellow Jews, young and old, when the shofar is sounded, when Kol Nidrei is chanted and when Neilah closes out the High Holy Day Services.

## **PARALLEL SERVICE — IN THE ARBACK HALL**

**8:30 AM ROSH HASHANAH | 9:00 AM YOM KIPPUR**

Our Parallel Service is a traditional service with an informal attitude. The service, led by Rabbi Leslie Lipson is a combination of a Camp Ramah and the late Rabbi Shlomo Carlebach's minyan. Like camp, it invites participation for men, women and children in an informal environment. And, like a Carlebach minyan, there is lots of singing, with stories interspersed in order to explain various prayers. Children of all ages are welcome as the sounds of children only enhance our experience. So, if you prefer to sit close to the action and be part of a small, intimate, participatory service, then this is the service for you!

## **YOUNG FAMILY LEARNER'S MINYAN —**

**10:15 AM - 12 NOON IN THE KELMAN CENTRE**

Are you a family with children under bar/bat mitzvah age looking for a High Holy Day service the whole family will enjoy? Are you hoping to find a place where kids and parents can learn together and have fun? Then this is your minyan!

Jeff Springer leads an abridged service in Hebrew and English, with some davening, some singing, some story telling and a whole lot of candy thrown in as well. Using a machzor (prayer book) specially adapted for young people, Jeff leads parents and children together in prayer and discussion, explaining many of the ideas in the High Holy Day service. Services finish with a fun game like Jewpardy and a snack.



In these circumstances, the charity should request a written declaration as to the identity of the true donor from the party providing the donation."

# Frequently Asked Questions

**1. Over how many months can I divide my payments?**

You can divide your credit card payments over a maximum of 10 months, as long as the first payment is made at renewal and the final payment is dated prior to May 31, 2019. Cheque payments limited to 6 cheques only.

**2. What time can our children / grandchildren join us in the Sanctuary?**

Children may join you in the main service at 12 noon. If you would like them to join you before this time please purchase a Sanctuary child ticket for them.

**3. When am I going to get an honour?**

We aim to honour as many members as possible. If you have never received an honour and would like one, please contact Freda at extension 233.

**4. When do I get my tickets?**

We will begin mailing tickets in August to all members who have paid. Wednesday, August 22 is the last day we will mail tickets. After this date tickets must be picked up from the Synagogue office.

**5. Can our payments go past May 2019?**

No. For accounting purposes we must have all payments in before May 31, 2019 (the end of our fiscal year).

**6. Do we have to pay the full amount? What if I cannot afford it?**

We try our hardest to accommodate your needs. If you require a financial adjustment, please request a form from the office or find it online: <http://www.beby.org/membership.html> and submit in confidence to the attention of Pearl Grundland, Executive Director.

**7. If my company pays the membership, can I get a tax receipt?**

You will be required to submit a donor declaration form which can be found on page 19 or by calling Sari Birnbaum, ext 221 or emailing [reception@beby.org](mailto:reception@beby.org).



# Privacy and Accessibility @ BEBY

## Privacy Information

Beth Emeth Bais Yehuda Synagogue (the “Shul”) is concerned about your privacy. In keeping with the Personal Information Protection and Electronic Documents Act (also known as PIPEDA), the Shul has developed a formal privacy policy which deals with the types of personal information we collect, how we collect and use it, and how we store and protect it. If you have concerns about the use of your personal information, you must inform the Shul office in writing, after which you will be contacted, in order to review your options. If you decide to withhold consent, this may limit our ability to provide services to you. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the Shul’s privacy officer Pearl Grundland, Executive Director, at the Shul office.
