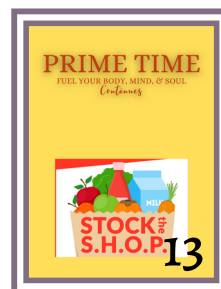

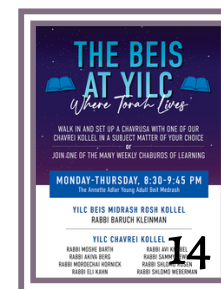

A NEW RESTART

One of the distinguishable prayers in our Yomim Noraim, is the Aleinu prayer. We say it every Mussaf of Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur, both in the private recitation and in the repetition of the amida. Why this prayer and why now? The Sfas Emes argues that this particular prayer has a unique history. It was in fact composed at the time of Yehoshua bin Nun, during the era of first generation of Israelites to inhabit the land of Israel. This makes sense because the prayer itself reflects a strong desire to remove paganism from the land and establish the kingdom of Hashem in

this world. The sad thing is that those dreams were never fully realized. Paganism was never fully wiped out. Assimilation was always an issue. It seems like a far cry from the aspirations in the prayer. Yet, maybe that is precisely why recite it during this time of year. We also had aspirations. We also dreamt of better futures for ourselves and our families. And yet, sometimes life was so complicated, it just got in the way. We take the time now, to reconnect to our dreams and reevaluate what it will take to get closer to them. This Yomim Noraim season in YILC, we have tried to provide many opportunities for every person in the community to grow and aspire again. Please take advantage of the many ways to reconnect with your dreams.

May it be a new and happy beginning this year of 5784.
