Dear Friends,

Welcome to the Tiferes Yisroel 30th Anniversary Concert! We have been looking forward to this evening with much enthusiasm. Your presence here tonight is meaningful to us as we join together b'achdus for a night of music and celebration.

Our holy Torah teaches us that the power of music and song is great. The songs and music of the Levites were a daily part of the avodah in the Bais HaMikdash, and the Simchas Bais HaShoaiva celebration on Sukkos with its music and dancing is considered by our chachamim to be the highest form of simcha.

A point of reflection on the music in the Bais HaMikdash is that it has two facets. One facet of the music is its ability to create an atmosphere of "d'veykus," closeness to G-d. Refined music opens up the heart and soul of the person who hears it. We can all relate to the experience of being expanded

and opened up by special music. The second facet is that the music itself is the act and experience of d'veykus. The music of the Levites is described by our chachamim as "Service in the name of Hashem."

In the musical experience, we can often find ourselves going back and forth between the two. Perhaps we could say that it is similar to Shabbos in this regard—Shabbos creates the tone for the whole week, and it is also the actualized goal and destination of the week.

Tonight we have a unique opportunity to be uplifted by the beautiful music and singing of our dear friend Eitan Katz. We are privileged to welcome Eitan and excited to tune in to his moving compositions and style.

Mazel tov to our honorees, our close friends and longtime shul members and supporters Dr. Jerry and Elka Rottman, and Ken and Chana Birnbaum. We thank these two special families for putting so much "koach" into Tiferes Yisroel and for helping us to reach our "ben shloshim l'koach" milestone. Kein yirbu b'ezyras Hashem!

Honorees

Ken and Chana Birnbaum



Ken and Chana Birnbaum have been mainstays of the shul since shortly after its founding. They moved their young family to Baltimore from New York in 1988 to find larger living quarters and a saner commute without sacrificing the benefits of a flourishing Jewish community. Soon they had found their niche in the two-year-old shul in the garage, just up the hill from their house. To complete the family feeling, they also joined the Goldbergers' car-pool.

Ken was "born under the roller coaster in Coney Island" and grew up in Sheepshead Bay, Brooklyn. He has fond memories of staying with his grandparents on the Lower East Side every Sukkos, where he would help carry meals down five flights to the communal sukkah in which Rabbi Moshe Feinstein zt"l also ate, and of attending his grandfather's shul on Delancey Street, where there were spittoons and only Yiddish was spoken.

When Ken met Chana, she was a physician assistant (PA) student, helping with screenings he was running for the American Cancer Society. She was unlike anyone he had ever met — a breath of fresh air. Chana had grown up in a stone house outside Doylestown, Pennsylvania, built in 1875 and rebuilt from ruins by her father at her mother's request. The PA field was new when Chana entered the program at Touro College. Ken recalls seeing her in the street right after she had taken her board exams.

"Someone asked her, 'How'd you do?' She said, 'Oh, I think I passed.' That was like — in my world, nobody talked like that. Everything was always horrible." Chana's practical, sunny nature

shines through in everything she does, whether it's playing violin or piano, knitting, crocheting, or, in her husband's words, "doing nice things for people without expecting anything back."

While studying at Touro, Chana began exploring the Orthodox Judaism she was exposed to by her roommates. Eventually she decided to embrace Orthodox Judaism. She credits her parents with giving her a sense of the immediacy of G-d's presence and care, and of the responsibility to follow His directives. By the time Ken was getting to know her, Chana was hosting groups of friends for Shabbos meals. He followed her into more robust observance.

Ken is a history maven and a fitness buff, as well as an actor; he appeared in *Liberty Heights* as an extra. His career in insurance has afforded many opportunities for the couple to travel. His favorite aspect of Yiddishkeit is one he says is observable in Gibraltar and Amsterdam, as well as at TY: the interpersonal relationships forged through going to shul.

Over the years, the Birnbaums have contributed to the life of the shul in many ways. Ken, who served as president of the Cross Country Improvement Association from 2005 to 2010 and was his company's top insurance salesman for the past decade, has been a key fundraiser for the annual banquet phone-a-thon. Chana, a PA in outpatient neurology at Sinai, has coordinated shiva meals since the pre-internet era and is consistently a first responder in chesed. The Birnbaums have found in the Rabbi and his Rebbetzin a source of warmth, Torah study, and consultation and support in raising their family.

The Birnbaums' children are Josh, who is head of Intermediate Medical Care at Sinai Hospital and the father, with Erica, of Ella and Judy; Yaakov, who lives in Anne Arundel County and works for the State of Maryland; Yoni, who lives in Jerusalem with his wife, Oshrat, and works as an administrator in Yeshivat Oraitah in the Old City of Jerusalem; Elisheva, who lives in Silver Spring with her husband, Michael Franco, and is working toward a degree in special education, and Reuven, who studies physics in the doctoral program at the University of Illinois, Urbana. The Birnbaums enjoy spending time with their grandchildren and with Ken's parents, who now live in Baltimore as well — a four-generation family. Ken has attended a Gemara shiur at Yesodei HaTorah for the past 10 years, and Chana is working on her Hebrew in preparation for the couple's goal of making aliyah.

Honorees

Dr. Jerry and Elka Rottman



The fledgling Congregation Tiferes Yisroel received a meaningful vote of confidence in 1991, when Dr. Jerry and Elka Rottman moved from New York to join the shul. The Rottmans had known the Goldbergers in Denver, where Jerry grew up and the Rottmans lived as a young couple, davening together in the home of Rabbi Shlomo Twerski zt"l. They stayed in touch after moving to New York. After Elka came to Baltimore for the bar mitzvah of a friend's son, she went home and shared with Jerry her excitement that she had finally found their shul! A year later, they made Baltimore and TY their new home.

Both Jerry and Elka had faced trials on the brink of adulthood that propelled them toward a deeper connection to Yiddishkeit. A shul trip to Israel led by his parents after his freshman year of college made a deep impression on Jerry. Searching for wisdom, he turned to Jewish tradition. He decided to leave college and, after spending six months teaching himself Hebrew, went back to Israel to learn. Eventually he returned to the States to finish college at Stanford with a degree in economics, followed by a master's degree in physics. He went to medical school at the University of Colorado and completed his residency at Albert Einstein in the Bronx.

Elka found herself in Israel under tragic circumstances, after the loss of her younger brother, Eddie (Eliyahu), in a car accident when he was 15 and she 21. She was looking for answers to life's meaning and purpose. After her parents took her to Israel and hired a scribe to write a sefer Torah in her brother's memory, she stayed on to become one of the first students in the newly founded Neve Yerushalayim seminary. Coming close to HaKadosh Baruch Hu was a kind of therapy, Elka says. She feels that her brother shares the credit for her To-

rah-observant life, and for every mitzvah that has flowed from the decision to follow that path.

Jerry's career in medicine has included research on magnetic resonance imaging of blood flow in the heart and development of software for the clinical laboratories at Johns Hopkins. He has worked as a medical coding auditor and currently teaches physics to Ner Israel pre-med and pre-dental students. Intellectual curiosity and a lifelong love of physics led him to write a book about the development of optical theory by the astronomer Johannes Kepler.

Elka has a master's degree in counseling. In Denver, she ran women's support groups and did individual and career counseling. Since their first child was born, her family has been her career. The Rottmans' children are Ayda, Elisheva, Eliyahu, and Tehila. Ayda is a special education tutor at Bnos Yisroel and lives in Baltimore with her husband, Rabbi Eyal Bendicoff, also from Baltimore, and their son Shalom Aryeh Leib, named for Elka's father, Leon (Aryeh Leib) zt"l. Elisheva has certification in early childhood education and works for Dvora Sora Reznick in her licensed family day care. Eliyahu learns at the Mir Yeshiva in Yerushalayim. His wife, Bracha (nee Klein, from Baltimore), works as a CPA, and their son is Yossi. Tehila and her husband, Avi Safren, of Lakewood recently returned from their shana rishona in Eretz Yisroel. Their newborn daughter, Meira Zahava, was named for Elka's mother, Gloria (Golda) zt"l. Elka's parents also lived in Baltimore after Elka's mother fell ill in 2007. It was an honor and a privilege to help care for them, Elka says, and they felt very connected to Tiferes Yisroel. They had known Rabbi Twerski and felt that he would have been very proud of Rabbi and Rebbetzin Goldberger. The shul became the recipient of the sefer Torah commissioned in their son's memory.

Over the years, Elka has volunteered with organizational and fundraising activities in the shul, including the challah sale, the Simchas Torah seudah, and the Management Team. She is now co-president of the Sisterhood, which raises fun and funds for the shul through activities such as the Coffeehouse Concerts and Melave Malkas, which helped sponsor the kitchen renovation in memory of Rebbetzin Miriam Lowenbraun zt"l.

Torah learning is at the core of the Rottmans' life. Jerry maintains multiple learning sedorim, including several hours weekly by phone with their son, Eliyahu, in Israel. (They have been learning Rosh Hashana, "the one place where there's a little bit of astronomy in the Gemara.") Elka attends two of Rabbi Goldberger's weekly shiurim — Shmuel Aleph and Derech Hashem. The couple feel blessed to be part of such a warm, growing community at Congregation Tiferes Yisroel under the capable and charismatic leadership of Rabbi and Rebbetzin Goldberger.

Our Guest Entertainer Eitan Katz



Best known for his niggun “L’Maancha,” Eitan Katz has devoted his career to keeping the fire of Jewish music burning. His compositions honor the language of Tanach and tefillah through original, soulful melodies, performed with delicate sincerity and passion. He lives with his family and learns in yeshiva in Far Rockaway.

Katz grew up in L.A. and Eretz Yisroel surrounded by music, the son of well-known cantor and music teacher Avshalom Katz. He frequently performs with his brother Shlomo, a musician and rabbi in the tradition of Shlomo Carlebach.

He earned a master’s degree in counseling with the intention of becoming a therapist, but as his musical career grew, he had time for little else, and he has earned his living exclusively through music for the last decade, playing weddings and touring throughout the United States, Israel, and South Africa.

Katz met Rabbi Goldberger through Nossi Gross, leader of Baltimore’s Zemer Orchestra and Katz’s mentor in the music business. Of Rabbi Goldberger, Katz says, “We share a spiritually focused music. He reached out to help me, and that made a special closeness to him. I love him a lot.”

The goal of his art, says Katz, is “to bring out the essence of what Jewish music is supposed to accomplish. Especially for this generation, which is craving honesty and moments of clarity like nothing else, it needs to be in the tool book of life. People can attain high levels of spirituality through the right music.

“Even within a profession that lends itself to being attached to the Jewish world, you have to have that balance between its being a job, and what it takes to be good at it, and the sensitivity to the fact that you’re dealing with something holy — for example, a speaker has to be funny and charismatic, which has nothing to do with the essence, yet you need that to get the message across.

“What’s the *ikkur*, the essence, and what’s the *taffel*, inessential? If the entertainment value of the music gets too far from the focus on it as a tremendous tool Hashem gave us to express our nashamos in a pure way, the more the *koach* (strength) of it has the ability to mess it up.
