- The entire right side of the men's section will be allocated to women; and men who normally sit on the right side are invited instead to sit in the center or on the left side (orientation: facing the Holy Ark.)
- To the extent that we run out of seats downstairs, men will also be invited to sit in the center balcony section, and in the left balcony.
- The Heyman Auditorium will be set up to accommodate Tot Shabbat youth programming, with regular youth groups for children in Nursery - 2nd Grade on the 8th Floor.
- Congregational Kiddush for the entire community - including the Sephardic Minyan - is across the street in the Ramaz Middle School Auditorium. It will be a lavish Kiddush, not to be missed!
