


Membership Commitment 2022-2023

Your Membership Commitment, as part of Our Shared Commitment model, helps cultivate purposeful Jewish engagement for all synagogue members and provides a home for every soul who wishes to join our synagogue family. While we recognize that our members have different means and that each donation is personal, we ask that all members consider making a Membership Commitment at the **Sustaining Amount of \$3,685**. The Sustaining Amount represents the total contributions per household necessary to cover the annual operating expenses as projected for this year at Congregation Beth El.



Our Synagogue Home

We take our name, Congregation Beth El, from Torah scenes in which our patriarch Jacob names the place at which he senses God's presence. "Come, let us go up to Beth El," he declares. About Beth El, Jacob rejoices, "What an awesome place this is." We, too, believe our synagogue is an awesome place to go up to that we may elevate our sights and raise our spirits.

We view Congregation Beth El as our spiritual and communal Jewish home. A home in which we celebrate, learn, and create community. A home in which we seek to live meaningful Jewish lives. As a synagogue family, we gather for many occasions. We care for one another and the Jewish people. We serve others and our society.

In Hebrew, home or house is *Bayit*, **BEIT**, for short. As taught by Jewish tradition, we enter our synagogue home in three ways.

**Ours is a House of Community,
BEIT Kneset, or Beth El Is Together.**

**Ours is a House of Prayer,
BEIT Tefillah, or Beth El Is Tefillah.**

**Ours is a House of Learning,
BEIT Midrash, or Beth El Is Torah.**

Ours is a synagogue home of many other things, too. Most of all, ours is a synagogue home for you. A home in which you belong and connect with others. A home for you to attend, to participate in, and to volunteer through as you may choose. In our synagogue home, we seek to live meaningful Jewish lives.

The Meaning of Membership

At Congregation Beth El we are each part of a larger community embracing us as we encounter the ups and downs of our individual and family lives. The values, heritage, and relationships touching our lives as synagogue members sustain us. We gain inspiration, support, and home in a synagogue community personalizing for us what it means to be part of the Jewish People.

We belong here because we can't be the Jews we aspire to be alone. We need each other. Membership in Congregation Beth El is not be like belonging to any other organization. Belonging to Congregation Beth El reminds us that by giving something of ourselves to others we discover how much more purpose and perspective we receive in return.
